

Glendale Technology High School Sport Information - Years 7 - 10 Term 3, 2022

Dear Parents/Carers/Guardians,

The new rotation of sport for Term 3 will commence on 21st July (Week 1). We are implementing a new process to make sport selections easier and fairer for busy families.

On **Monday 20th June** at 3.15pm families and students will receive an email providing a link to make sport selections.

Through this link, you will need to:

- 1. Select the students preferred sport and payment method.
- 2. Payments can be either made online via the school website (and receipt number included on the online form) or at school within 48 hours of selecting the sport.
- 3. Complete and hand in any further Permission Notes and/or Venue Waivers required.

Sport choices are on a 'first come, first served' basis – once a sport is full it will be removed from the online form and students will need to select an available sport.

There are options for sport both on and off school grounds. Students attending sport offsite will require parental permission (note attached) to attend, this is mandatory under the State Sport Policy and some sports require further venue waivers (see over for details).

All notes and waivers will be available on the GTHS website and at Student Services and must be handed to Students Services before 1 July 2022 for the student to attend sport.

Costs

All sports requiring bus transport incur an upfront fee of \$40 for the term, and some sports incur a weekly venue fee (see over for further information).

If a student is unable to make a weekly venue cost, they must report to myself (Mrs Irish) in the PE staffroom prior to roll call on sports day for placement in alternate school sport for the week.

NOTE: Any students who do not make an online selection and/or return the required permission note/s on time will be allocated to a sport on school grounds.

The following sports are currently on offer and will only run if there is enough interest. All choices must be finalised (including all notes received) by Friday 1 July at 2.10pm.

NOTE: Depending on availability, students may be able to change their sport selection after Week 2, Term 3.

Sport Options for Years 7 – 10 Term 3, 2022

The following sports are held on site at school and incur no bus or venue costs.

School Sport	Venue	Description and Requirement Students engage in Just Dance activities.	
Dance Cardio	Classrooms		
Table Tennis	Classrooms	Students participate in an indoor table tennis competition.	
Recreational Sports	Classrooms/Handball squares	Students engage in a range of recreational sports such as handball, bocce, cornholes.	
Boys Mixed Sport	Bottom Oval/High Shelter	Variety of competitive and non-competitive sports each week. All year groups. Boys only.	
Girls Mixed Sport	Lower Grounds/MPC	Variety of competitive and non-competitive sports each week. All year groups. Girls only.	
Court Sports	Basketball Courts	Variety of competitive and non-competitive court sports each week such as basketball and volleyball.	
Mountain Biking	Local bushland	Students will learn how to maintain their bike and ride around the local bushland tracks.	
		*Students must have a helmet that meets Australian standards, a mountain bike appropriate for offroad use and a bottle cage or similar, to transport water.	
		*Permission note required as students will leave school grounds.	
Bushwalking	Local bushland and Tramway Track	 Students utilise the local bushland and walking trails outside of school. 	
		*Permission note required as students will leave school grounds.	

The following sports are held at external venues and require bus transport. They offer the greatest diversity and are consistently the most popular. Costs should be considered, as some incur a weekly venue fee, in addition to the upfront bus transport fee.
