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## Year 11 Gold Coast Trip 2023

This year, Year 11 students have the opportunity to participate in a trip to the Gold Coast. The purpose of this excursion is to strengthen relationships as students commence their final years of schooling.

### When

Students will depart Glendale Technology High School on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> June at 5.45am and return Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June, 5:30pm (approximately).

### Transport

Students will travel via coach and utilise coach transport while moving between venues at the Gold Coast.

### Location and Brief Itinerary

Students will be accommodated at the NRMA Treasure Island holiday resort. Students will visit, Sea World, Movie World, Dream World and explore the shopping venues and Top Golf on the Gold Coast. A more detailed itinerary of days and times has been attached to this note.

### Cost

**A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is payable prior to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023 to lock in the student's seat.**

The balance of \$520 is due for payment prior to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023. That is an approximate total cost of \$620 per student. **Final cost will be confirmed once deposits have been closed.**

Places are limited to 74 spaces. Please note failure to meet payment deadlines will result in no refund. Student assistance is not available to support students attending the trip. Please also note Travel Insurance is not included, therefore no ambulance cover is offered whilst in QLD. Families may wish to seek their own personal Ambulance cover.

Student accommodation, travel by coach, top golf and theme park entry is included in this cost. Students will be required to purchase lunch on some days at their own expense. This information is included in the itinerary attached.

### Eligibility

Students who have received a suspension, suspension caution or have outstanding assessment tasks between 2<sup>nd</sup> March and the date of travel will be excluded from participating in the trip.

### Equipment and Personal Belongings

Students will be provided with an equipment checklist and further details of the required personal belongings closer to departure date. The school is not responsible for the loss or damage to any personal belongings that students bring.

### Boarder Closures

In the event the boarder is closed preventing travel, a new date will be coordinated in consultation with the venue.

Further permission notes and details will be provided closer to the departure date. To secure a seat on the excursion please complete the attached permission note and return along with the non-refundable \$100 deposit to the Student Administration Office prior to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023.
