Year 9 Canberra Trip 2023

This year, Year 9 students have the opportunity to participate in a trip to the Canberra. The purpose of this excursion is to strengthen relationships and learning experience at various venues.

When

Students will depart Glendale Technology High School on Monday 27th November at 7.30am and return on Thursday 30th November at 2.30pm

Transport

Students will travel via coach and utilise coach transport while moving between venues at Canberra.

Location and Brief Itinerary

Students will be attend venues such the War Memorial, Questacon and Canberra Zoo to name a few. A more detailed itinerary of days and times will be available shortly.

Cost

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is payable prior to Friday 4th August to lock in the student's seat. The balance of \$420 is due for payment prior to Friday 20th October 2023. That is an approximate total cost of \$470 per student. Final cost will be confirmed once deposits have been closed.

<u>Places are limited to 80 spaces.</u> Please note failure to meet payment deadlines will result in no refund. Student assistance is not available to support students attending the trip. Please also note Travel Insurance is not included, therefore no ambulance cover is offered whilst in ACT. Families may wish to seek their own personal Ambulance cover.

Student accommodation, travel by coach, all activities entries are included in this cost. Students will be required bring/purchase lunch on the first day at their own expense. This information is included in the itinerary attached.

Eligibility

Students who have received a suspension, suspension caution or have outstanding assessment tasks between 2nd March and the date of travel will be excluded from participating in the trip.

Equipment and Personal Belongings

Students will be provided with an equipment checklist and further details of the required personal belongings closer to departure date. The school is not responsible for the loss or damage to any personal belongings that students bring.
