### Year 11 Gold Coast Trip 2024

This year, Year 11 students have the opportunity to participate in a trip to the Gold Coast. The purpose of this excursion is to strengthen relationships as students commence their final years of schooling.

#### When

Students will depart Glendale Technology High School on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June at 5.45am and return Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2024, 5:30pm (approximately).

#### **Transport**

Students will travel via coach and utilise coach transport while moving between venues at the Gold Coast.

#### **Location and Brief Itinerary**

Students will be accommodated at the Gold Coast Performance Centre. Students will visit, Sea World, Movie World, Dream World and explore the shopping venues and Top Golf on the Gold Coast. A more detailed itinerary will provided closer to departure

#### Cost

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is payable prior to Friday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2024 to lock in the student's seat. The final balance will be due for payment prior to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2024.

The approximate total cost of \$550 per student. Final cost will be confirmed once deposits have been closed.

<u>Places are limited to 67 spaces.</u> Please note failure to meet payment deadlines may result in no refund. Student assistance is not available to support students attending the trip. Please also note Travel Insurance is not included, therefore no ambulance cover is offered whilst in QLD. Families may wish to seek their own personal Ambulance cover.

Student accommodation, travel by coach, top golf and theme park entry is included in this cost. Students will be required to purchase lunch each day, and breakfast on the last day, at their own expense. This information will be included in the itinerary.

#### **Eligibility**

Students who have received a suspension, suspension caution or have outstanding assessment tasks between 7th March and the date of travel will be excluded from participating in the trip.

#### **Equipment and Personal Belongings**

Students will be provided with an equipment checklist and further details of the required personal belongings closer to departure date. The school is not responsible for the loss or damage to any personal belongings that students bring.

Further permission notes and details will be provided closer to the departure date. To secure a seat on the excursion please complete the attached permission note and return along with the non-refundable \$100 deposit to the Student Administration Office prior to **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2024**.
