

Glendale Technology High School Sport Information and Permission notes for Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 *Term 4, 2019*

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Students will need to make a \$45 payment in week 8, 9 or 10 of Term 3 to cover the cost of buses for the term. IT IS ON A "FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED" BASIS - ONCE A SPORT IS FULL STUDENTS WILL HAVE TO SELECT ANOTHER SPORT. Students will require parental permission to attend sport. The permission form is mandatory under the state sport policy. In an attempt to streamline this process, I will outline all the sports that may be offered. Each student may then nominate sports from that list, following the return of the permission note.

SCHOOL SPORTS are those held at school, most of which are free. They may include:

^{*} Students wishing to participate in Bushwalking at school will need to complete the permission note to leave school grounds**** Parents need to complete a waiver form ALSO if their child has chosen Parrey Skatepark, once bus fee is paid. See Sport teacher or office staff***

NOTES:

- 1. All the above sports will be offered Term 4. However, some sports may not run if student interest is not high enough.
- 2. Students choosing a sport outside of school will be required to pay a \$45 fee for the buses. (This will occur starting week 8 till week 10 of Term 3). Students MUST have their permission note with the \$45 payment to secure their place. This will cover the cost of bus travel for the entire term. Students will then need to pay for the venue entry on sports day.
- 3. Once the bus payment is made, students **will not be able to claim a refund** if they are away on sports day, change sports to a non-paying sport or are sent to sports detention or non-sport. Bus ordering and payment are organised based on the amount of money collected prior to each term.
- 4. Students with disciplinary problems, such as behaviour or truancy issues, may be placed in the Theory of Sport group.
- 5. Cost is an important consideration, and it should be noted that the school has no control over bus or venue costs. The above prices are correct at the time of publication. There may be alterations during the year.
- 6. Changes to sport choices will be made only on financial or medical grounds and only on MONDAYS, TUESDAYS or WEDNESDAYS.
- 7. Students are to priortise 4 choices on their selection sheet, as some sports may be full at the time of sport selection, and their next choice will be selected. **Payment for the buses MUST be made at the time of selection.**
- 8. Students who fail to choose a sport will be allocated a school sport by the sport organiser.
- 9. If up front payment is a problem please speak to me to see if we can make another arrangement.
