Changes to Subject Selection Process

Due to COVID-19 restrictions not being ease by the commencement of Term 3 we have been required to make some changes to our processes for Subject Selection.

To ensure parents are well informed of the requirements for the subject selection process we will be providing the following options:

Printed Information Booklet – Students will receive their information booklets during the week commencing 10th August. I encourage you to read this booklet carefully as your child will commence the journey where they have control over their pattern of study in 2021.

Website Information – We will launch a video for each subject area including some important videos on how the process works and how students are to choose their subjects on Monday 17th August. Be careful to choose the correct section, ie Year 8 Interest Elective.

Online Information Session – We will conduct a brief information session with the ability for parents to ask questions from <u>5pm– 5.30pm on Tuesday 18th August</u>. Parents can join the session via Zoom using the details below. Attached to this letter is an instruction sheet on setting up Zoom.
